

Discussion Outcomes and Looking Forward

Affirmation and adjustments to the existing Aerosol Measurement Strategic Plan...
...with an eye to future needs w.r.t. frontiers in process science and ARM endeavors
(LASSO, AMF3 SEUS)

<u>Locational deployments</u> – instruments/measurement suites specific to target science at ARM sites <u>Sampling paradigms</u> – everything everywhere (statistics) vs intensive IOPs/data epochs (process); spatially distributed measurements

<u>Supporting Modeling</u> – evaluation vs process representations call for different measurement paradigms <u>Vertical Profiles</u> – linking in situ and remote sensing of aerosol properties throughout the column <u>Data quality</u> – communication of calibration and processing protocols

<u>Data Accessibility</u> – aerosol product presentation on Data Discovery is overwhelming requiring simplification and documentation to guide users efficiently to the appropriate data
